Extensive support is provided to CoRE members to assist each member to identify actions that are in line with both the evidence base and their core business, and that are sustainable, systems level changes where possible.

- ✓ **Professional suite of CoRE resources:** guides, tools, audits, videos, policy examples and other relevant information
- ✓ **Leadership briefings** to Boards and executive leadership teams
- ✓ **Individual meetings** for tailored support with the CoRE liaison person or group in each organisation to provide specific expertise in identifying and documenting the actions they will take as an organisation.
- ✓ **Training** for staff:
  1. Prevention of Violence against Women: An introduction (3hrs);
  2. Intensive Bystander training (6 hrs); and
  3. Gender Equity for Managers (2hrs).
- ✓ **Community of Practice** sessions for key staff in CoRE organisations to come together and share and learn from one another – to help both with planning and implementation challenges, and provide new resources as they are developed. Sub-regionally based to support local coordination and networking. 3 per year in each subregion.
- ✓ **Act@Work** – is an intensive workplace based program that some members also elect to do. This program works with an Action Group to develop a comprehensive action plan and includes training for all staff. This program attracts a fee to cover the costs for the intensive staff support provided.
